

MEET THE DEVELOPER

WLB Developer, David Hynes, will be at the Bronte Beach Precinct Committee on **Wednesday Dec 5th**. The precinct committee meets at the Lugar Brae Church Hall, Lugar Brae Lane from 8pm. We need a really big turn out to show him we don't want this WLB-RSL shopping mall development.

Save Bronte Village has met with, and presented to, the Clovelly Public School P&C and Mr Peter Monks, Director Planning & Environmental Services Waverley Council.

The School P&C have been very supportive and they are rightly concerned about the adverse impacts of this development on the school community. They are writing a submission to the Council on these impacts.

Mr Monks took time to listen to our concerns about the proposal. He assured us of the Council's independence with regard to any development at the RSL site. He reiterated the Council's preference that the developer does not submit either a DA or a planning proposal to amend the LEP before the Council has completed the site specific review. This review should be presented to Council by March 2013.

On Sunday 25th November, many Save Bronte Village supporters attended the Mayor's Mobile Office at the Bronte Bowling Club. Our elected representatives were left in no doubt that our community is saying NO to this shopping mall development. Good work villagers!
