

Send your emails now - Rezone RSL 9m Residential

The Waverley Councillors will be meeting this week for a workshop on the planning controls at the Macpherson St and St Thomas St Neighbourhood Centre. It is our understanding that the council planners have completed their review and will be discussing it with the Councillors at this upcoming workshop. The report will then be tabled at the February 19 Council meeting where the Councillors will vote on any changes they wish to make to the planning controls at the Bronte RSL site.

It is very important that we email/write to **all** the Councillors now, before they meet, and ask that the planning controls be strengthened. **Ask the Councillors to rezone the RSL site residential** (+/- existing use rights for the RSL Club) and to return the height limit to its previous **9 metre level**. The worst case scenario is that the Councillors help the WLB-RSL partnership by slackening the controls to allow their multi-storey shopping proposal to be approved. Don't let this happen - please take 5 min today to fire off an email to all the Councillors (the email addresses are in this newsletter.)

Make sure you put February 19 in your diaries. We need a massive crowd at the council meeting to show the Councillors how strongly the community feels about this overdevelopment.



The massive size of the proposed WLB development is clearly shown in this diagram. It is at least 2 times (and more likely 3 times) the permitted size.

What you can do now!

I. Write to Waverley Council and local MPs

- Write to all the councillors and ask for the Bronte RSL site to be rezoned 'Residential'
 with a 9 m height limit in the new site specific controls
- Ask Malcolm Turnbull to support us, his constituents, as he has supported those at Rose Bay (Marina proposal) and those around Sydney Harbour (Helipad proposal).
- Thank Bruce Notley-Smith for his support

2. Use Social Media
