As usual nothing is ever simple with regard the Bronte RSL site. There are now two meetings that our community needs to attend in full force.

JRPP meeting July 25

We have had word today that the State Government planning panel (known as the JRPP) will meet on July 25 to "determine" the development application (DA 72/2013) for the RSL site. What this means is that after 8 months of talk, the Bronte RSL DA will either be rejected or approved on July 25th. If you made a submission on the DA, you have the right to speak at the JRPP meeting. Individuals get 3 minutes to talk whereas the developer will get 15 minutes. We should all register to speak. As individuals the system will ignore us but, as a community speaking loudly as one, the system can't ignore us. Register to speak <u>here</u> now!

This JRPP meeting is a separate, but equally important meeting, to the Council meeting on July 16th.

Council meeting July 16

On July 16, the Councillors will vote on their own planning proposal for the Macpherson and St Thomas Street Neighbourhood Centre. We have asked that they rezone the RSL site medium density residential (R3) which still allows shops but only small ones. We have also asked for the height limit to be reduced to 9.5 metres (3 stories) which is in keeping with the surrounding streetscape.

This Council meeting is our last chance to ask our Councillors to represent us and not outside interests. It is our last chance to determine the future of Bronte together. **Please send the Councillors an email today** and ask them to ensure their Waverley LEP amendments include:

- 1. Rezoning the Bronte RSL site R3
- 2. Reducing the height limit to 9.5m

If the Councillors don't include these changes in the new LEP, then it is clear that they do not represent the residents. Their email addresses are hyperlinked below.

Please join us at both the July 16 Council meeting (7pm) and the July 25 JRPP meeting (5pm). Don't forget to bring your signs and wear your SB t-shirts. Both meetings will be held at the Council chambers on Bondi Road.
