Members will vote on RSL club's future

BRONTE RSL Club, at the centre of a controversial development, may soon wind up in liquidation, with residents concerned a nightclub may open on the site.

Club members were last week invited to a meeting on June 11 where a vote will be held to send the RSL into voluntary liquidation, with remaining assets given to the Bronte Surf Life Saving Club.

Save Bronte spokesman Stephen Lightfoot said the group was surprised by the announcement.

"We're very concerned that the developer and subbranch want to put some other sort of licensed premises on the site like a nightclub."

Coogee state Liberal MP Bruce Notley-Smith said if the RSL Club folded, there "should not be a provision for a licensed club or licensed premises" on the site.
