Save Bronte community members elected to Bronte RSL Club board

Members of the Save Bronte community group have been elected to the Bronte RSL Club board.

COMMUNITY members that have fought to stop the redevelopment of the Bronte RSL Club have been elected to its board.

The Friends of Bronte RSL Group contested and were elected to fill all seven positions on the board at last night's annual general meeting.

Many are members of the Save Bronte Community Group, who have been vocal in their opposition to a proposed six-storey residential and retail space on the Macpherson St site.



The proposed redevelopment of the site is in the hands of the State Government.

Save Bronte co-founder Stephen Lightfoot said he was hopeful Planning Minister Pru Goward would now step in to stop the proposal.

"She can't ignore this tsunami of community support and protest," he said.

Dr Lightfoot said the new board was expected to release a statement this week that states its opposition to the development.

"Their policy is they don't want the RSL Club used as a weapon against their community," he said.
